My Dear Parishioners,

This is our first Christmas together, here at Resurrection of Our Lord Parish. There are many changes to look back on.

Christmas is a very special time for each one of us, and it is important that we keep it special, regardless of what is happening around us. Make it special for your family, your friends, and yourselves. We live in very difficult times; times of anxiety, and division, where practically every message coming to us from the outside world is "hard" and causes pain.

As you know, Jesus was born at a time when it was very difficult for people. Life was a struggle; without freedom, safety, there was hunger, and poverty.
