Feast of the Baptism of the Lord

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord is liturgically the last day of the Christmas Season.

It is not frequent that Christmas and New Year's fall on a Sunday. Since Christmas usually falls on a day other than Sunday, then the Sundays after Christmas are usually:

- 1st Sunday, Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph
- Weekday, January 1st Mary, the Holy Mother of God
- 2nd Sunday, Epiphany of the Lord
- 3rd Sunday, Baptism of the Lord

Ordinary time usually begins on Monday, the day after the Baptism of the Lord (3rd Sunday) and through to the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday.

When the Feast of the Epiphany falls on Sunday January 7th or Sunday January 8th, then the Baptism of the Lord is observed on Monday, instead of on Sunday.

This year, for these reasons, the Baptism of the Lord will be celebrated on Monday, January 9th, and Ordinary Time will begin on Tuesday, January 10th and continue on through until Tuesday, February 21^{st} , the day after being the beginning of Lent – Ash Wednesday, February 22nd.
