Eucharistic Adoration

Adoration is the first attitude of man acknowledging that he is a creature before his Creator. It exalts the greatness of the Lord who made us (Ps 95:1-6) and the almighty power of the Savior who sets us free from evil. Adoration is homage of the spirit to the "King of Glory," (Ps 24:9-10) respectful silence in the presence of the "ever greater" God. (St. Augustine) - (*Catechism of the Catholic Church – 2628*)

Rejoice and be glad, timid soul, because the Creator of all will take up His dwelling with you; the King of the heavenly choirs is coming to you; the strong, omnipotent God is coming to you... Immerse yourself in the ocean of the love of God. (The Spirituality of Father Jordan -p. 49).

"This grace is at times so great, that the fullness of acquired piety not only strengthens the soul but also the weak body." (Imitation of Christ, IV, 1st chapt., 6)

The term "adoration" indicates the form of worship that man offers to God, acknowledging him as Creator and Lord of the universe. ... With the Father, he adores Christ, the incarnate Word, exclaiming with the Apostle Thomas: "My Lord and my God!" (Jn 20-28). (Theotókos, Woman, Mother, Disciple, A Catechesis on Mary, Mother of God JOHN PAUL II -p. 248)

There must always be people in the Church who leave everything in order to follow the Lord, people who depend radically on God, on his bounty by which we are fed – people then, who in this way present a sign of faith that shakes us out of our heedlessness and the weakness of our faith.
