**Almsgiving Lenten Observance
and Charity work for Ukraine**

In our Christian life during Lent, we have the beautiful
tradition of almsgiving whereby we take from ourselves
to give to others. The exercise and goodness of it is
that we are giving up a thing that we enjoy. Resigning
from something we like means we are practicing our
abstinence and at the same time we can help others.
Both are good for our personal progress, especially at a
time when abstinence is expected and a time said to be
to give alms.

As I was telling you during Sunday Masses two weeks
ago, I am encouraging our parish to support parishes
and communities in Ukraine. (It would mean
supporting not only those parishioners, but extending
to hospitals and other individuals there.)

Almsgiving means to give with no name attached to
the offering.

Whatever you give up, the money would be put aside
over the course of Lent and placed in an unmarked
envelope with the words 'Almsgiving for Ukraine'
written on it, and dropped in one of the locked boxes at
the entrances of the church.

But when you give alms, do not let your left hand
know what your right hand is doing,
so that your almsgiving may be secret.

And your Father who sees in secret will repay you.
(Matthew 6:3)

So I thought it necessary to encourage the brothers to

beautiful gift and not as an exaction. Consider this:
whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and
