St. Christopher is the patron saint of travelers and of children. He is one of the most popular Saints of the East and West. There are many legends concerning this Saint. One of the most popular of them holds that St. Christopher was a giant who helped people across a raging stream. It is believed that he carried the Christ Child across this same stream. Hence, his name Christopher, Christ-bearer. He is Patron of motorists, and is invoked against storms, plagues, etc. He died a Martyr during the reign of Decius in the 3rd century and is one of the Fourteen Holy Helpers invoked for emergencies or afflictions. The Importance of Saying the Rosary. The Fathers of the spiritual life in the Deuteronomic and prophetic traditions insist that prayer is a remembrance of God often awakened by the memory of the heart. "We must remember God more often than we draw breath." (St. Gregory of Nazianzus.)

Within The Tradition of the Church breathes rhythms of prayer such as morning and evening prayer, grace before and after meals, the Liturgy of the Hours, Sundays, centered on the Eucharist, the cycle of the liturgical year, and its great feasts.

The Lord leads all persons by paths and in ways pleasing to him and the personal expressions of their prayer.

Christian Tradition has retained three major expressions of prayer: vocal, meditative and contemplative.

Vocal prayer, founded on the union of body and soul in human nature, associates the body with the interior prayer of the heart, following Christ's example of praying to his Father and teaching the Our Father to his disciples. It is a basic need of our human nature to pray out loud. God asks it of us from the depths of our souls and also by vocal prayer.

Jesus raised his voice to express his personal prayer, from exultant blessing of the Father to the agony of Gethsemani.

Meditation is of great value, but Chrisitan prayer should go further: to the knowledge of the love of the Lord Jesus, to union with him.

Contemplative prayer at its beginnings is vocal.

Contemplative prayer is the simple expression of the mystery of prayer. It is a gaze of faith fixed on Jesus, and attentiveness to the Word of God, a silent love. It achieves real union with the prayer of Christ to the extent that it makes us share in his mystery.

Through his Word, God speaks to man. By words mental or vocal, our prayer takes flesh. Yet the heart should be present. (It doesn't depend on the number of words, but on the fervour of our souls. – St. John Chrysostom)
