The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults
at Resurrection of the Lord

RCIA: Introducing the Catechumenate: "The catechumenate is not a mere expounding of doctrines and precepts, but a training period in the whole Christian life, and an apprenticeship duty drawn out, during which disciples are joined to Christ their Teacher."

(Ad Gentes 14)

R.C.I.A. is the "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults", a document flowing from Vatican II, which directs and supports the process through which people are initiated into the community that gathers at the table of the Lord. It describes a process by which people are guided and cared for by the community as they awaken in faith and are gradually introduced to Jesus the Christ and his Body, the Church.

The RCIA process is a series of carefully planned stages, marked by liturgical rites celebrated in the presence of the whole community, in which newcomers embark on, and join the community in a continuing and deepening journey of conversion into faith and discipleship; this is the Catechumenate. It takes into account the distinctive history and spiritual needs of all people who seek baptism as they are "...introduced into the life of faith, of liturgy, and of love which is led by the People of God."

(Ad Gentes 14) As they go from stage to stage, these people are known successively as the *Inquirers*, the *Catechumens*, the *Elect* and the *Neophytes*.

The RCIA also provides adaptations of the Catechumenate to be used in serving the needs of baptized but uncatechised people, as well as the needs of mature, practicing Christians from other faith traditions, and the needs of other people in special circumstances. These people are known as the Candidates for Full Communion throughout the process of completing their initiation.

These designations are important since they indicate not only the stages where each individual is at in the process but also proclaim their relationship to the Church and may, in certain circumstances, indicate a legal aspect of that relationship.

The process is modeled on the Catechumenate of the ancient Church. Christian faith demands deep commitment because our beliefs and the beliefs of our society are often in tension. The Church revived the Catechumenate because new believers in the modern world need careful preparation and caring support as they enter into the mysteries of Christ and the commitment of Christian living.
