**PRO-LIFE APOLOGETICS**

**Pro-abortion claim:** *Babies are better off aborted than being put in broken-down foster care systems where they suffer.*

**Pro-life response:** The answer to bad situations and abuse is not to kill the one who suffers, but to try to end the suffering. Most people would be horrified at the idea of going into a foster home and killing the children because they are suffering there. People recognize that they are human and deserving of rights and protection, including the right to life. Since it's not morally acceptable to kill born children to end their suffering, the same goes for preborn children, since they too are full members of the human family and deserving of rights and protection, including the right to life. It is always wrong to kill an innocent human being, no matter their size, location, or stage of development. It's suffering that needs to end, not a child's life.
