MEN'S ROSARY - CURRENT SCHEDULE

Indulgences for the Souls of the Faithful Departed: Since the faithful departed now being purified are also members of the communion of saints, one way we can help them is to obtain indulgences for them, so that the temporal punishments due for their sins may be remitted. (CCC. 1479). By a plenary indulgence is meant the remission of the entire temporal punishment due to sin so that no further expiation is required in Purgatory. A partial indulgence commutes only a certain portion of the penalty; and this portion is determined in accordance with the penitential discipline of the early Church. (CCC. 1471)

Indulgence Requirements: To acquire a plenary indulgence, it is necessary to fulfill the following three conditions: 1. sacramental Confession, 2. Eucharistic communion, and 3. prayer for the intention of the Holy Father while being detached from sin. It is appropriate that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulgenced work is performed; but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act. The condition of praying for the intention of the Holy Father is fully satisfied by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary. A plenary indulgence can be acquired only once in the course of the one day.

Visiting a Cemetery: An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. Typically, the indulgence is plenary each day from November 1-8.

Visiting a Church on November 2: A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who on the day dedicated to the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (November 2), as well as on the Sunday preceding or following it, and on All Saints' Day, piously visit a church. In visiting the church, it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited.
