A Prayer of Sorrow (Act of Contrition)

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee, and I detest all my sins because I dread the loss of heaven and the pains of hell, but most of all because I have offended you, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace to confess my sins, to do penance and to amend my life. Amen.

#### <u>Absolution</u>

Listen to Father's words of absolution, and make the Sign of the Cross.
