The Cleansing of the Leper: A leper went to Jesus (and kneeling down) begged him and said, "If you wish you can make me clean." Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, and said to him, "I do will it. Be made clean." The leprosy left him immediately, and he was made clean. Then warning him sternly, he dismissed him at once. Then he said to him, "See that you tell no one anything, but go, show yourself to the priest and offer for your cleansing what Moses prescribed, that will be proof for them." The man went away and began to publicize the whole matter. He spread the report abroad so that it was impossible for Jesus to enter a town openly.

If you are cured, possible is it that you will be treated as if you haven't been. It's something you have to be prepared to accept. It wasn't good enough for the leper to have been near to Jesus and cured by him. That was other-worldly. It appears to be that what the leper wanted was a worldly benefit from his cure – meaning to be personally recognized as now being clean and so be able to expect more out of what the world could offer than he could have expected before. It wasn't enough for him to have simply been touched by the hand of God.

Jesus remained outside in deserted places, and people kept coming to him from everywhere.

Mark 1:40-45
