EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

Is it not incredible that the Wise Men recognized that by following the star, they would find a King. They were pagans, and Herod king of the Roman Territory of Judea called them to tell them to search diligently for the child. At that time, the king of the territory listened to Wise Men from the East, took them seriously, and believed them about matters that had to do with faith.

The Wise Men brought gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh, and knelt down and paid the child, who was with his mother Mary, homage. When they went home, they did so by another way.



According to an ancient tradition, one can distinguish between two senses of Scripture: the literal and the spiritual. (The spiritual sense is subdivided into three categories: 1. Allegorical; 2. Moral; and, 3. Anagogical senses.)

The profound concordance of the four senses guarantees to all, the Scripture's richness to the living reading of it in the Church. (CCC115)

GOLD, FRANKINCENSE, MYRRH.

If you have the time to read and the resources to read from, this is what the Catechism of the Catholic Church (116, 117) explains sound writings about Scripture will describe. The 'literal' is the meaning of the words of Scripture. The 'spiritual sense', is God's plan in the realities and events Scripture speaks about.

GOLD: symbolizes Jesus' role as a King.
FRANKINCENSE: symbolizes Jesus' role as a High Priest.
MYRRH: symbolizes Jesus' role as a Martyr – His death and suffering for the salvation of the world.
