### *Resurrection of Our Lord Parish Lenten Retreat*

You are invited to join the Sisters of the Queenship of Mary Community for a three-part Lenten mission, as we journey with Mary in preparation for the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Our Lord. The mission is entitled 'Heart of Surrender: Journeying Through the Seven Sorrows of Our Lady', and will meditate upon the swords that pierced the heart of Mary over the course of her life, exploring the ways we can imitate her model of virtue and total surrender to God.

The Queenship of Mary Community began in Ottawa, ON in 2007, under the direction of Archbishop Emeritus Terrence Prendergast, SJ. The charism of the community is to imitate the love and service of our Blessed Mother by proclaiming Christ to the spiritually poor. **Ash Wednesday Masses**

Wednesday, February 14th is Ash Wednesday. Ashes will be distributed at both the 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Masses.

Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence from meat of similar food.

**PENITENTIAL DISCIPLINE**

All the faithful in their own way are bound to divine law to do penance; however, in order for the entire community to be joined in a common observance of penance, penitential days have been prescribed during which the faithful are asked to engage in a special way in prayer, works of piety, and charity, deny themselves by fulfilling more faithfully their responsibilities, and observe fast and abstinence according to canonical norms.

In the Catholic tradition, fasting means to consume only one full meal a day. Two smaller meals equal to or less than one full meal are allowed as an alternative. Abstinence within fasting means not to eat meat. It is also expected that meat is to be given up on Fridays during Lent.
