### *Resurrection of Our Lord Parish Lenten Retreat With Sisters of the Queenship of Mary*

The mission is entitled 'Heart of Surrender: Journeying Through the Seven Sorrows of Our Lady', and will meditate upon the swords that pierced the heart of Mary over the course of her life, exploring the ways we can imitate her model of virtue and total surrender to God.

The Queenship of Mary Community began in Ottawa, ON in 2007, under the direction of Archbishop Emeritus Terrence Prendergast, SJ.
