BEFORE GOING TO CONFESSION, PLEASE REMEMBER

Church tradition and psychology tell us that Confession is not only a powerful Sacrament, but also good for the soul. It lifts burdens, relieves guilt, forgives sins, and starts us on a new path of this spiritual journey.

Five conditions for a good Confession

1. Examination of Conscience: An examination of conscience is prayerfully thinking about what we have purposefully said or done, that hurts others and our relationship with the Lord our God. For your preparation, use a good examination of conscience based on the Ten Commandments.

- 2. Sorrow for your sins against God and Others.
- 3. Resolve to sin no more.

4. Confession of our sins: We need to confess all our sins, without concealing any of them, including mortal and heavy sins, otherwise the Confession is not valid.

5. Penance: A penance is a special task we are given by the Priest to help repair the damage our sin has caused to our relationship with God or others. Penance may include doing something nice for someone we have wronged, taking up a "good habit", or saying a special prayer.
