FIRST SATURDAY DEVOTION

These First Saturday Prayers to the Immaculate Heart of Mary are recommended for those participating in the Five First Saturdays devotion, which originated from the 1917 apparitions of the Virgin Mary in Fatima, Portugal, during which she asked for acts of reparation on five consecutive first Saturdays of the month. It involves going to Confession, receiving the Eucharist, reciting the rosary, and meditating on its mysteries for 15 minutes on the first Saturday of five consecutive months, with the intention of making reparation to Mary's Immaculate Heart.

The Promises of Holy Mary

Our Lady promises her assistance and graces especially at the hour of death, as well as peace and consolation in families and eventual salvation for those who faithfully practice the First Five Saturdays devotion. It involves attending Mass, receiving communion, praying the Rosary, and meditating on its mysteries on 5 consecutive first Saturdays with the intention of making reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Act of Reparation (To be recited on the First Saturdays)

Most Holy Virgin and our beloved Mother, we listen with grief to the complaints of thy Immaculate Heart, surrounded with the thorns which ungrateful men place therein at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude.

Moved by the ardent desire of loving thee as our Mother, and of promoting a true devotion to thy Immaculate Heart, we prostrate ourselves at thy feet to prove the sorrow we feel for the grief that men cause thee, and to atone, by means of our prayers and sacrifices for the offenses for which men return thy tender love. Obtain for them, and for us, the pardon of so many sins. A word from thee will obtain grace and forgiveness for us all.

Hasten, O Lady, the conversion of sinners that they may love Jesus and cease to offend God, already so much offended, and thus avoid eternal punishment. Turn thine eyes of mercy towards us so that henceforth we may love God with all our hearts while on earth and enjoy Him forever in Heaven. **Amen.**
