*The Invitation to Holy Paschal Triduum,
from our Pastor*

My dear parishioners,

Easter is coming, and soon we will celebrate the resurrection! But before Easter there are three special days – the days of the Paschal Triduum.

1) **Holy Thursday** - this is the day of Last Supper, the day of Jesus' prayers in the garden of Gethsemane, and the day when Jesus was arrested. The most important of these for us today is the Last Supper, because it is during that moment with the disciples that Jesus instituted two sacraments - the Eucharist and Holy Orders (the priesthood). Holy Thursday is the day when we celebrate the Eucharist in a solemn way and we pray for our priests. For the priests who have ministered to us before, for those who minister to us today, and for those who will minister to us in the future. For those priests who have passed away, those who have left the priesthood and those that need God's mercy. I ask that you please pray on this day for all priests. Happy feast day to our priests!

2) **Good Friday** - on this day we participate in Jesus' Passion and death. We accompany Him in His suffering. We sympathize with him. But also, we thank him for the redemption that He accomplished on the cross. We are with him in this day by our prayers, fasting, and participation in the liturgy of Good Friday.

3) **Holy Saturday** - this is a significant day because it marks the time when Jesus Christ was buried in the tomb, fulfilling the prophecy of His death and resurrection. It is a time of preparation and reflection. It is also a time of hope as Christians remember that death has been defeated and that new life is possible through faith in Jesus Christ. It is on this day that we celebrate the Easter Vigil:

The Roman Missal states: "Of this night's Vigil, which is the greatest and most noble of all solemnities, there is to be only one celebration in each church. It is arranged, moreover, in such a way that after the Lucernarium (liturgy of the light) and the "Exultet",

The Easter Proclamation, Holy Church meditates on the wonders the Lord God has done for his people from the beginning, trusting in his Word and promise (the second part, that is, the Liturgy of the Word) until, as day approaches, with new members reborn in Baptism (the third part), the Church is called to the table the Lord has prepared for his people, the memorial of his Death and Resurrection until he comes again (the fourth part)."

These 3 days of the Easter Triduum are very meaningful for the history of salvation, for our own personal salvation and for the Easter celebrations. For this reason, I would like to invite every one of you to attend all of these Holy days so that you may be more aware of the roots of our faith, the historical and spiritual origin of these days and of the significance of the Easter holidays themselves.

PENITENTIAL DISCIPLINE

Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence from meat or similar food.
(Cannon Law)

In the Catholic tradition, fasting means to consume only one full meal a day. Two smaller meals equal to or less than one full meal are allowed as an alternative.
Abstinence within fasting means not to eat meat.
