## Blessing of the Seeds LORD's DAY Masses, April $27^{\text {th }}$ and $28^{\text {th }}$

The parable of the Sower is in all three Synoptic Gospels (Matthew 13:1-9, Mark 4:1-9, Luke 8:4-8). In this Gospel Jesus says the seed represents the Word of God (the Gospel), the Sower represents anyone who proclaims it, and the different kinds of soil represent how people receive that Word. The parable is based on an ordinary yearly event, the sowing of seeds. Planting time was the same when Jesus walked this earth and continues to this day and will never change. Every spring (April in the northern hemisphere or September in the southern hemisphere), seeds are planted to provide us with the food we need. And, it is our responsibility to pay heed to the gift God has given to us in seeds and ask for His blessing of the seeds. This blessing will be on the $5^{\text {th }}$ Sunday of Easter, after all Masses.
