First Reconciliation - First Holy Communion

At the entrances to the church are letters from the parish inviting families for the sacramental programs for next year (2025) beginning this coming fall: (First Reconciliation - First Holy Communion as well as Confirmation).

We would like to be able to get in touch with your families before the summer holidays begin so that you can make an appointment to register as soon as you are able. The letter explains our program and the attachment to the letters outlines this past pastoral year's (2023-2024) program to give an idea about the commitment involved for preparing the children, including the day of the week the classes take place.

It is likely that you know the ages for receiving these sacraments, but just to mention:
First Holy Communion (Age 7) Grade 2
Confirmation (Age 11) Grade 6

The ages/grades aren't mentioned in the letters, so this is an explanation.
