As Canada prepares for the Federal Election (early voting opened on April 16th), we are reminded "that voting is a responsibility," one "that we should approach [...] believing 'this is an act of love and service.'" - 1. Dignity of the human person from conception to natural death; [abortion and euthanasia]
- 2. Call to family, community and participation;
- 3. Rights and responsibilities;
- 4. Option for the poor and vulnerable;
- 5. The dignity of work and the rights of workers;
- 6. Solidarity;
- 7. Care for God's Creation.

We are now experiencing another Easter! Seemingly the same as before, and yet not like anything we have ever seen.

If anyone thought that nothing of any interest would happen in our world, they were wrong. The world is very dynamic. A lot of things, both bad and good, are happening. Political systems and alliances are changing. There are wars, diseases. The only thing that doesn't seem to change is that we are constantly scared of someone or something, and we become more and more terrified. Are you afraid that something will happen - that prices will go up, that there will be a war, that you will get sick? Are you afraid that you will die? I believe we are afraid to leave this world.

This last point is in fact our destiny, and thus death and resurrection are our destiny. The question is not if but WHEN will it happen?

Easter is a time when God, in this world full of confusion, mutual accusations, hatred and confrontation, gives us signs. But what sorts of signs?

Firstly, there are positive ones, supernatural ones, where something is added to our lives and people are brought back to God. There are Eucharistic miracles, conversions, people approaching the Sacrament of Reconciliation after years and receiving Communion once again.

And then there are signs where God shows us He is still in control by the reduction of those things that go against His will – in some places in the world the number of abortions and incidents of euthanasia have decreased, or actions taken so that males can't compete in sports as females.

But what is the greatest Sign?

The most awesome and the only timeless one - the Resurrection! It all started with this. After this sign the disciples believed and began to teach, spreading the faith to all ends of the world. Take note: there is no greater sign in this world from God than the Resurrection of Jesus! It is a sign of hope, of love. But there is also power that flows from the Resurrection - energy, strength, and courage.

Therefore, in this overwhelming world full of information, news, and difficulties, let us stop for a moment and think about Jesus - as "the Way, Truth and Life" - our ultimate destiny. Let's fall in love! Let's fall in love with Him again. He alone will give us the strength to fight the evil that is around us, but also that which is within us, and that is the most difficult thing for us to defeat on our own.

Jesus is wonderful! Why? Because He gives us what we need the most. He satisfies all of our needs. Those of love, faith, prayer and relationship (both to the Almighty and to our Community). Through prayer He builds bonds in us, giving us a sense of meaning in life. He gives us supernatural graces - faith. He shows that after death something exists, that after this life there is another, and it is there that He is waiting for us, in the Father's house. He is with us in the sacraments!

Without the Cross, suffering and Resurrection, it would be difficult to live, to overcome difficulties and illnesses, carry our daily crosses, seek happiness and satisfy our needs, both physical and spiritual. Thank you, Jesus, for the miracle of the Resurrection! Saint Augustine put it beautifully:

"The season before Easter signifies the troubles in which we live here and now, while the time after Easter which we are celebrating at present signifies the happiness that will be ours in the future. What we commemorate before Easter is what we experience in this life; what we celebrate after Easter points to something we do not yet possess. This is why we keep the first season with fasting and prayer; but now the fast is over and we devote the present season to praise. Such is the meaning of the Alleluia we sing." - St. Augustine of Hippo
