

Blessing of the Crops and those who Work the Land May God bless all farmers, and those who toil in the fields to bring us our food and drink. Watch over them and provide growing conditions that make this year's harvest plentiful. We also ask you God the Father to protect those who toil in the fields that their farm equipment may not fail, and that they be protected from farming accidents.

Liturgical Time. The Liturgical Year begins with the Season Advent which leads into the Christmas Season. There is a short period of Ordinary Time after the Christmas Season and then begins Lent. Lent ends three days before Easter Sunday (the period in between being the Triduum - Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Saturday). When the Easter Season begins, on Easter Sunday, it lasts for 50 days, spanning from Easter Sunday until Pentecost. Right now, Ordinary time has resumed, and will continue until the Feast of Christ the King the last Sunday of the Liturgical year and then the Liturgical years begins again on the first Sunday of Advent.

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. O most holy heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore you, I love you, and with lively sorrow for my sins I offer you this poor heart of mine. Make me humble, patient, pure and wholly obedient to your will. Grant Good Jesus that I may live in you and for you. Protect me in the midst of danger. Comfort me in my afflictions. Give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death. Amen.

Memorial of The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church (Monday, June 9th). The Virgin Mary is at once Mother of Christ, the Son of God and mother of the members of his Mystical Body, which is the Church. Mary standing beneath the cross accepted her Son's testament of love and welcomed all of us to be reborn unto eternal life. As a caring guide to the emerging Church Mary had already begun her mission in the Upper Room, praying with the Apostles while awaiting the coming of the Holy Spirit. At the conclusion of the Third Session of the Second Vatican Council, the Blessed Virgin Mary was declared as "Mother of the Church, that is to say of all Christian people, the faithful as well as the pastors, who call her the most loving Mother". It was established that "the Mother of God should be further honoured and invoked by the entire Christian people by this tenderest of titles".

This celebration will help us to remember that growth in the Christian life must be anchored to the Mystery of the Cross, to the oblation of Christ in the Eucharistic Banquet and to the Mother of the Redeemer and Mother of the Redeemed, the Virgin who makes her offering to God.

(Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments Decree on the Celebration of the Blessed Virgin Mary Mother of the Church in the General Roman Calendar.)

Mary said yes at the very beginning, but it wasn't upon her initiative to establish her place. Mary was asked. It would seem so foreign when so many times it is we who decide to take matters into our own hands. For us what Mary did would be difficult in many ways – most of all because she was the Handmaid of the Lord. Mary waited.

(We will celebrate this Feast at the Confirmation Mass.)
