The Fruits of Eucharistic Adoration

In the Catholic Church, Eucharistic Adoration is a practice which is a sign of devotion to Jesus Christ, worshiping Him. It is believed by Catholics that the consecrated host, which is sacramental bread, is present the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ.

Eucharistic Adoration begins, and the Blessed Sacrament, the sacred host, is removed from the tabernacle at the beginning of exposition, by a priest or deacon, and placed in the monstrance – brought to the altar for adoration by the faithful.

Within the teachings of the Second Vatican Council is said:

“By worshiping the Eucharistic Jesus, we become what God wants us to be! Like a magnet, The Lord draws us to Himself and gently transforms us.”

What are the fruits of Eucharistic Adoration?

“This is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks upon the Son, and believes in Him, will have eternal life.
I will raise Him up on the last day” (Jn 6:40)

Eucharistic Adoration deepens our understanding of the Mass. Anyone who observes regular weekly Eucharistic Adoration will experience a deeper devotion to Jesus.

“The act of Adoration outside of Mass prolongs and intensifies all that takes place in the Liturgical Celebration itself” (Pope Benedict XVII)

Eucharistic Adoration leads to a growth in holiness.

“There is no doubt that a flood of graces will descend upon your family and the world if more souls would become pupils of the Eucharist” (Pope John XXIII)

Eucharistic Adoration affords us the opportunity to experience greater inner peace and contentment. It enables us to make reparation for sins committed especially sins against the Blessed Sacrament. It gives us an opportunity to experience many extra graces and blessings, for ourselves, our families, and our parish community. (St. John Bosco)
