Archdiocesan Mass for the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation September 30, 2025.

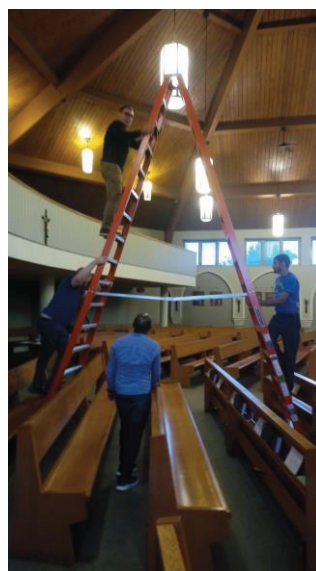
