RCIA

(Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)

Have you been thinking about joining a Catholic Parish?

Do you want to be in a full relationship with the Catholic Church, receiving Holy Communion as a Catholic?

If yes, you are invited to join The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). RCIA is for anyone who is not yet baptized. It is, as well, for anyone who has been baptized in another denomination and would like to join the Catholic Church. RCIA is also for anyone who would like the opportunity to broaden their knowledge about the Catholic Church so as to participate fully in the celebration of Holy Mass.

As this pastoral year begins, it is a time to count our blessings and to recognize the goodness of God from whom all good things come, and we celebrate this with a family feast called 'the Eucharist'. Would you like to join us at the table of the Lord's Eucharist but can't because you are not Catholic? Want to do something about it? Call Resurrection of our Lord Parish office.

WHAT IS RCIA?

RCIA is described as a journey, a process. The process of the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults** prepares a person to be a full member of the Catholic Church. The purpose of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the preparation of catechumens or candidates for the sacraments of initiation, namely: Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, and for the sacrament of Reconciliation for those who were baptized previously and preparing themselves to receive the other sacraments.

Participants in the RCIA are known as catechumens. (The core of the process of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is to be found in the 'Period of the Catechumenate' – the time of preparation of a catechumen.)

The Rite affirms that the Period of the Catechumenate "is an extended period during which the candidates are given suitable pastoral formation and guidance aimed at training them in the Christian life" (75 [Latin 19]). It is indicated that this is to be achieved in four ways. It is these four ways that build Church: catechesis, community, liturgy and apostolate.

Through RCIA, the faithful are born anew by Baptism, strengthened by the sacrament of Confirmation, and receive in the Eucharist the food of eternal life. By means of these sacraments of Christian initiation, they thus receive in increasing measure the treasures of the divine life and advance toward the perfection of charity.

The process has as its purpose the creation of Church. Lived and celebrated faithfully, the process not only adds members to the Church, but also clearly affirms who the Church is.

The three sacraments of Christian initiation closely combine to bring us, the faithful of Christ, to full stature and to enable us to carry out the mission of the entire people of God in the Church and in the world!
