

PROMISES and VOWS

PROMISES: by our Baptism, Confirmation, Matrimony or Holy Orders, we live our life according to a promise we have made to God. Prayer, alms-giving, or pilgrimages (as well as other personal devotions) are also ways to make a promise to Him. Holding true to our promises made to God is a sign of the respect we owe to God who is faithful to us.

VOWS: To take a vow means to empty ones' self as fully as they are able following Jesus' self-emptying for us as our Saviour – and for us apart from anything else which our means would allow. (There is nothing in us that can satisfy a Vow - it is only by the hand of God.)

There is no monetary value to a Promise or a Vow. They are commitments freely made by us to God to give the things of this world up and live for Him.
