To Know God - As families grow, they need something to show them the way. Everyone has to be aware so as not to be lured when things are hard along the way into something untrue that makes a thing non-existent given as a good answer. It's true that the way of life was different 500 years ago. However, for some, whether then or now, they live asking questions so as to know God. There aren't really words specific, but our Holy Father Pope Leo XIV has begun a new series of Catechesis dedicated to the Second Vatican Council. It has to do with "the mystery of Salvation and the unity between God and his people." Pope Leo has asked, "Is there life in our Church? Is there space for what is being born? Do we love and proclaim a God that sets us back on the path? We cannot close ourselves off and say, everything has already been done, finished, and do as we always have done. Our Holy Father extended a warm welcome to all the English-speaking pilgrims and visitors taking part in the day's audience, especially those from England, Ireland, Australia, Canada and the United States of America, saying - to all of you and your families, I offer my prayerful good wishes for a new year filled with joy and peace. In today's Gospel, John the Baptist testified, "I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and remain on him [Jesus]. I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain is the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' And I myself have seen and have testified that this is the Son of God." [There are many who are not yet baptized – as wasn't the criminal who was on the cross beside Jesus that defended Jesus just before his death. Jesus said to him, "Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in paradise." (Luke 23:43) Blessed Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan, (Society of the Divine Saviour) said: "As long as there is one person on earth who does not know God and does not love God above all things, you dare not allow yourself a moment's rest." **For some live asking questions so as to know God.**
