NORMS FOR LENTEN OBSERVANCE

- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. Fridays are days of abstinence.

Fasting binds all persons from 18 to 59 years, unless prevented by poor health. On days of fast, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's own needs. Eating between meals is not allowed although fluids may be taken.

Abstinence from meat binds all persons who are 14 and older, unless prevented by poor health. In the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall, the consumption of meat is not allowed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.

Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on the Fridays of Lent. The Archbishop mandates this observance for the spiritual well being of the faithful.

Lent is a penitential season and, as such, religious practices such as daily Mass, the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, the Stations of the Cross, works of charity and justice, and acts of self-denial are highly encouraged.

Both abstinence and helping others are good for our personal progress, especially during Lent when they are expected - a time dedicated to giving alms. **Almsgiving means to give with no name attached to the Offering.** Whatever you give up, over the course of Lent money would be put aside and placed in an unmarked envelope with the words "**Almsgiving for Philippines**" written on it, and dropped into one of the locked boxes at the entrances of the church.
