Paschal Candle: The Easter Candle is lit from the blessed fire at the Easter Vigil. The candle is placed on its candlestand next to the ambo having been lit from the Easter Fire. We are now in Ordinary Time and the Easter Candle is no longer next to the ambo. This Sunday is the Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time four weeks after Pentecost Sunday and from then on the Paschal Candle is lit during funerals and baptisms.

Votive Candles:

The Icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help is adorned at our side altar and is in the presence of burning votive candles lit for the many intentions of those who come to pray at the parish. Upon lighting a votive candle, it burns for approximately five days with the intention continuing for the duration, night and day.
