Roof Rehabilitation Project

Thanks to the generosity of our parish community, our Roof Rehabilitation Project continues to make steady progress.

In **October 2025**, the flat roof above the church's side entrance—the most critical section at the time—was completely replaced at a cost of just under **\$25,000**.

In **June 2026**, the Parish commissioned a comprehensive thermographic scan of the remaining flat roofs to help prioritize future rehabilitation work. The scan identified moisture in the insulation of the roof sections over the church addition, constructed more than 20 years ago. To prevent further deterioration, these sections should be rehabilitated before the onset of winter.

The project involves approximately **2,233 square feet** of roofing, with estimated costs ranging from **\$70,000 to \$80,000**. The Finance Committee has issued Requests for Quotations and expects to award the contract in the coming months so work can be completed as soon as possible.

The church complex includes **five flat roofs** of varying sizes, as well as the octagonal roof over the worship area. Our goal is to have **three of the five flat roofs rehabilitated by the winter of 2026**.

Looking ahead, the installation of eavestroughs on the octagonal roof will also be necessary to better manage increasingly heavy rainfall and protect the newly rehabilitated roof sections.

Your continued generosity is making these important improvements possible. Thank you for helping us preserve our parish home for generations to come.
